

Living is Easy in Rochester Apartments

What kind of apartments in Rochester should you be looking for? First think about what your lifestyle is like. If you are a young single, small studio or one bedroom apartments will do, and these can be found in a variety of settings. Living around downtown, Rochester apartments are often in multi story, attached buildings with an office and maybe some shops on the first floor. Think about how much noise you can deal with before moving into such a place, though. Detached apartment complexes are also available in Rochester, usually with two or three levels and one or two buildings grouped together on the same lot. These have less floors and may be less noisy. A ton of Rochester apartments are in houses that were converted for multi family use, though. Located on quiet, residential streets, these apartments are often in very pretty Victorian houses with a lot of history. A house converted into apartments may contain for or five units, sometimes with private entrances. The trade off for a more quiet setting, however, are older appliances, windows, and construction. To keep heating bills down, get plastic weathering sheets for drafty windows, but remember that you can also rent apartments that include heat. If possible, look for those first. Renting in a converted house is typically \$500 a month or more, while rents in complexes may run higher.

If youre looking for something a little more swank, Rochester has lofts, too. Lofts are usually in old commercial buildings that were converted into living space, and they tend to have some exposed brick, exposed piping in the ceiling, and open floor plans. Lofts are the route developers have gone with Rochester apartments in the past few years in their attempt to attract people to downtown. Although loft apartments can be pricey, Rochester has them for prices that beat out other cities. Loft rents start at around \$700 or so and can go up to \$1,500.
