Then just call and have them pick it up and store your things for you till you need them. You just unload your items once you call to have them delivered to your new home.

Military moving expenses are reimbursed whenever you incur them for a move to another base. Just make sure you keep all of your receipts because you will have to turn them in to get reimbursed. Any meals you and your family have to buy while in the act of military moving can be reimbursed too. The guidelines allow military moving expenses to be reimbursed for up to 3 nights in a hotel for moves. If you have to do any military moving it will be much easier if you plan well for it. Moving day will go a lot smoother if you plan for it well weeks in advance. You should make arrangements for a military moving company way in advance as well. If you are doing it yourself you need to make sure you have your moving van reserved. Put in a change of address according to military guidelines before your move.
